### Scholarship Application for Soils & Natural Resources Students

### <u>Eligibility</u>

To be eligible for this scholarship the student must be enrolled as a full-time student (12 credit hrs. or more/ semester) in a Michigan College or University with a major field of study in soil science, geology, natural resources management, or other related natural resources field.

The student may be enrolled as an undergraduate or as a graduate student.

The applicant must complete and submit the scholarship application form by <u>March</u> <u>15, 2011</u> to the address listed on the bottom of the form. They must also include a copy of their college transcript. They will be judged on involvement in projects, leadership, and major course work in soils and natural resources.

#### Award

Two scholarship awards will be granted in the amount of \$1,000. The awards will be granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, age, gender, sexual preference, or disability.

#### **Basis of Selection**

The scholarship applicants will be judged on pertinent course work, leadership roles in their field of study, earth-friendly volunteer work, and involvement in natural resources activities.
